



*In Search of Good Government: From the Grand Experiment to the Goochland Revolution* by Ken Peterson (The book tells how good government was done in one locality, Goochland) \$20.00, plus tax.

*Author and county supervisor, representing District 5, Ken Peterson tells how the search for good government succeeded in Goochland County. The turnaround story provides convincing evidence that an informed and engaged electorate has the power to fix a broken government.*

*Kill Jeff Davis: The Union Raid on Richmond, 1864* by Bruce M. Venter, \$25.00, plus tax.

*Using every scrap of evidence available, historian Bruce Venter reconstructs the ill-fated Kilpatrick-Dahlgren raid to free Union prisoners of war in Richmond. He convincingly attributes the failure of the raid mainly to Dahlgren's mistakes (some of which were made in Goochland) and finds the young colonel responsible for the notorious orders to assassinate Jefferson Davis and his cabinet. The book is as thrilling as the events it portrays.*

*The Battle of Hubbardton: the Rear Guard Action that Saved America* by Bruce M. Venter, \$21.99, plus tax.

*Set in Vermont, not Virginia, this is still a fascinating read for those interested in the American Revolution or military history. In fact, it was the only Revolutionary War battle fought in Vermont! British and German troops ran into stubborn rebel resistance at Hubbardton in July 1777 and the day would ultimately turn the tide for the Patriot cause. In the fields and hills around Hubbardton, a tenacious American rear guard of about 1,200 derailed British General John Burgoyne's plan for a quick march to Albany and led to his weakened forces ultimately surrendering at Saratoga in October of that year.*

*Rocks across the Pond: Lessons Learned, Stories Told by Richard and Kathy Verlander (parents of baseball great Justin Verlander), \$29.95, plus tax.*

*Who can resist Goochland's most famous sports hero or his parents? Kathy and Richard Verlander had no idea the turn their lives would take back in 1989 when a neighbor suggested that their son Justin sign up for Little League baseball. In 2008, they were selected as the George H. W. and Barbara Bush Little League Parents of the Year. The award is given to those who exemplify the best qualities of parents of young athletes who played Little League baseball and reached the major leagues. This book was written to benefit other parents raising young athletes, in the hope that they can gain something from their own experience.*

*Under Every Tree: A Guide to Finding Your Roots in Virginia by Phyllis Brock Silber, \$20.00 plus tax.*

*This little book (designed to fit in your glove compartment) is the only guide you will need to locate primary genealogy resources in Virginia. It provides basic information about, as well as detailed driving and parking directions to, the most helpful resources in each locality and suggests what to visit first for each county in the Commonwealth.*

*Bush Hogs and Other Swine and Chivalry Thy Name is Bubba by Robin Traywick Williams, \$15.95 each, plus tax.*

*For fun reading, try either or both of these titles by Goochland author Robin Traywick Williams. The short stories cover humorous escapades of family and locals, as well as common sense observations of life in the county. They are great books for a guest room and will keep your guests laughing all the way.*
